### 2.3. Application Procedure and required documents

The students nominated by their home university to carry out a mobility at “Gheorghe Asachi” Technical University of Iasi, Romania (TUIASI) will be contacted, after the nomination, by the person in charge with Erasmus incoming students from TUIASI.

To apply as Erasmus+ student at TUIASI students must access <https://www.erasmus-application.tuiasi.ro/> and follow all the required steps. The requested documents are:

- o a scanned copy of the student’s passport or national identity card;
- o a scanned copy of the student’s transcript of records with previous years of study;
- o a document/ certificate attesting the student’s level in English (B1 being the minimum required);

- o the student’s Learning Agreement – this document must be filled in at the home University with the student’s professor/tutors, with course units from the current semester.

Once the Learning agreement is approved by the Erasmus+ Faculty coordinator the incoming student will receive an Acceptance letter, issued by our university.

#### 2.4. Visa Application Procedure and required documents

The sending and receiving universities will provide the student with assistance, when required, in following the obtaining visa procedure, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education. ## 2.9. Grading System

Within the Romanian universities, a 10-point scale is used, 5 being the minimum grade for passing, 10 is the highest grade, 5 is the lowest passing grade. The approximation of the Romanian grades to an ECTS scheme for the subject area is assessed periodically by the Council of the Course of Study within each faculty; the current one for the Faculty is as follows:

- A, Excellent: outstanding performance fully meeting requirements: 10;
- B, Very good: a very good performance with only minor shortcomings: 9;
- C, Good: a good performance with a few notable shortcomings: 8;
- D, Satisfactory: fair with few significant shortcomings: 6 and 7;
- E, Sufficient: performance only meeting the minimum requirements: 5
- Fx and F, Fail: preparation totally inadequate: 4 and below

In our university 1 full academic year (Y) – 60 credits, 1 semester – 30 credits, 1 term/trimester – 20 credits.
